KET travels to Washington, D.C., for interviews with state's federal lawmakers

KET's *Kentucky Tonight* will feature live interviews with two members of Kentucky's federal delegation in a special episode airing Monday, June 24 at 8/7 pm on KET.

Hosted by Renee Shaw, the program will include a conversation with Kentucky legislators filmed inside the rotunda of the Cannon House Office Building in Washington, D.C.
